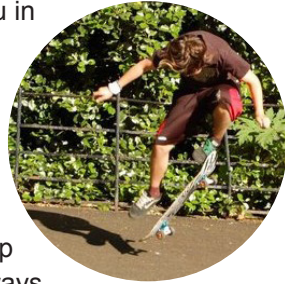




Children with Diabetes in the UK online community and email support list
